## Subject: Seeking extension in working hours on 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> August 2014

Modern retailing caters to the changing lifestyle needs of the customer and is based on convenience to customers. You may be aware that end of season discount sales are very useful for consumers in India. Retailers in India attract a huge number of customers during the Independence Day week end.

One worry that is synonymous to large number of customers coming to stores is that sale activities need to be wound up at normal shopping hours while the number of customers have not been catered to properly. Also if most customers come in from 5.30 to 8.30 PM, employees are put to pressure to deal with too many customers at the same time. We believe that an extended shopping hour increased customer convenience and also reduces pressure on employees.

Incidentally, this year, 15<sup>th</sup> August falls on a Friday and most of the retailers are offering Independence Weekend Sale on 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> August 2014. It would be a great help to the consumers, retailers and retail employees if retailer stores can be allowed extended hours of working up till 12.00 mid night on the days of Independence Weekend sale i.e. 15<sup>th</sup> August, 16<sup>th</sup> August and 17<sup>th</sup> August 2014.



We really appreciate sincere efforts taken by your progressive government last year by allowing retailers to keep their stores open 14 hours a day from October 27th to November 7thon account of festive season. Notification is attached herewith for your reference.

It is our humble request to kindly consider our request and issue a notification to this effect subject to retailers complying with all the necessary labour compliances. Our delegation will also be pleased to meet you to have a discussion in this reference.
